

MASS EVENT REGULATIONS

Mass Event Site and Mass Event Regulations for DREAMERSLAND 2027

Held at a venue designated by the Organizer in Poland (exact location announced no later than 8 September 2026).

Regulations of the Site and Mass Event titled “DREAMERSLAND 2027”

Taking place from **14 July 2027** to **18 July 2027** at a venue designated by the Organizer in Poland.

General provisions

1. These regulations (hereinafter: *Regulations*) are issued pursuant to the Act of 20 March 2009 on the safety of mass events (Journal of Laws of 2022, item 1466, 1700).
2. The Regulations are issued by the organizer of the event, **Dreamersland Sp. z o.o.** (hereinafter: *Organizer*).
3. The Regulations apply to all persons present at the site where the Mass Event is held; each person is required to comply with these provisions.
4. They set out the conditions of participation and rules of conduct, including participants' obligations, participation conditions, participants' rights and liability for conduct contrary to the Regulations.
5. Definitions: **Security Services** and **Information Services** are persons appointed by the Organizer (including security agency staff) identified with an ID card who ensure participants' safety; **Mass Event Site** means the designated area where the event is held; **Event Participant** means any person participating in the Mass Event.

Conditions of participation

1. Admission is free within the framework of a purchased Dreamersland 2027 ticket.
2. Hours of the Mass Event: 14–17 July, 16:00–03:00 (detailed schedule published on the Organizer's website).
3. Entry is prohibited to anyone subject to a ban on mass events; refusing security checks; under the influence of alcohol or drugs; carrying dangerous items, explosives, pyrotechnics, flammable materials or alcohol; behaving aggressively or concealing their identity.
4. Security and Information Services assess and qualify dangerous items.
5. The Organizer may refuse entry or remove anyone carrying dangerous items or violating prohibitions.
6. During the event it is forbidden to cover one's face, display obscene slogans, climb on infrastructure, throw objects, possess/consume alcohol or narcotics, light fires, bring pyrotechnics, damage infrastructure or block evacuation routes.
7. It is prohibited to bring weapons, ammunition, explosives, rigid containers (including bottles), helmets, pointed umbrellas, spray cans, vuvuzelas, lasers, advertising materials without consent, professional cameras, animals (except guide dogs) and banners/flags.
8. Entry to areas not intended for the public (stage, lighting equipment, poles, masts) is forbidden.

Rights and obligations

- Participants may stay on the site from opening to closing, use medical, sanitary and information points, use facilities as intended, obtain medical assistance and report damages to the Organizer.
- Participants must follow instructions from Security and Information Services, not disturb public order, comply with the Regulations, ensure others' safety, follow staff instructions and care for the environment.

Penal provisions

The Regulations reference Articles 54–59 of the Mass Events Safety Act, which provide fines, restrictions of liberty or imprisonment for disobeying security orders, bringing alcohol/pyrotechnics, covering one's face or bringing weapons. Courts may confiscate items used in violations.

Final provisions

1. Persons disturbing public order or violating the Regulations may be removed or handed over to the Police and are not entitled to compensation.
2. All rights to the event's name and logo belong to the Organizer.
3. Commercial, advertising or promotional activity without the Organizer's consent is prohibited.
4. The Organizer may record the event; entering constitutes consent to the use of one's image.
5. The Regulations are available at www.dreamersland.eu, information points and entrances.
6. They take effect on 14 July 2027 at 16:00 and remain in force until the event ends on 18 July 2027 at 03:00.
